COURT WATCH GIVES JUDGE TERESA VINCENT ITS CHILD SUPPORT DISTRICT COURT JUDGE AWARD

Greensboro: On October 22, 2009 at its Annual Child Support Awards Banquet, at GTCC, Court Watch awarded Judge Teresa Vincent its 2009 District Court Judge Award. This coveted award is given to the District Court Judge who has excelled in helping parents collect child support. The selection was made by a Court Watch committee, after reviewing the nominations received from the Guilford and Davidson County Child Support Enforcement agencies. The CSE personnel had observed Judge Vincent in child support court rooms, and were impressed with her ability to collect child support from absent parents. Comments included that Judge Vincent conducted her child support hearings in an efficient, courteous manner and that she was knowledgeable, consistent, firm and fair with all of the involved parties.

The CSE Support Staff Awards went to Maria Lewis of Greensboro, Kimberly Pass of High Point, and Celena Pittman of Davidson County.

The awards ceremony concluded with the presentation of the Bobby McGuire Award, which is given to an individual or organization in recognition for their exceptional contributions to Court Watch of North Carolina. This year's recipient was the law firm of Brooks, Pierce, McLendon, Humphrey & Leonard, LLP.
